

Service description for Internet Wi-Fi Single Access:

Access to the Internet is provided over a high-speed data network (gigabit network) available at Messe Wien and a high-performance, redundant connection to two different providers.

A controller-based Cisco Wi-Fi is in operation at Messe Wien, and the entire venue is comprehensively served by Cisco Wi-Fi access points of the newest generation. Due to the nature of Wi-Fi technology, however, limitations may result from booth structures or interfering signals. The Wi-Fi frequency range is license-free and is also used for other purposes (Bluetooth, radio microphones), and we can therefore make no guarantees with respect to the lack of interference.

With “Internet Wi-Fi Single Access” you receive an user account (username and password) in advance, bandwidth up to 10 Mbit/s in both directions, private IP address allocation via DHCP, fair use download volume, dedicated channels within the 5GHz band possible.

You need a 5GHz Wi-Fi-capable device. Activate Wi-Fi on the device, select the network “Messe Wi-Fi Advanced”, connect to the network, start a browser, open any page (e.g. www.kapsch.net), and you will arrive at the login page, enter your username and password and surf away.
